VEHICLE MOVEMENTS	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	Parents are encouraged to park on the road behind the Childrens' house Nursery and walk round through the gap in the hedge to the start of the trail. Impose 1-way system. Parents should NOT return through the hedge, rather walk round in a circuit Cubs to be escorted to and from the group by parents Parents and Leaders to be vigilant all drivers to be careful when manoeuvring	L	Maintain vigilance
