COVID 19 ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrival and departure staggered to maintain 'bubbles' if multiple groups are meeting and at distance. • One-way system through garden used for arrival/departure if operating near HQ • Cubs et al to sanitise hands on arrival and departure and at regular intervals using their own or group supplied sanitizer OR hot water with soap. COVID 19 SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT WHILST AWAY FROM BASE	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<p>APPOINTED FIRST AIDER ON THE WALK</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FIRST AID KIT to include foil blanket PLUS PPE of gloves, apron, eye shield & mask • If possible & casualty has minor injury they should 'self-administer first aid', under suitable guidance so suitable Social Distancing can be maintained. • PPE to be donned for anything other than minor • Leader in charge to have all numbers and contact parents immediately 	H	
PEOPLE GET LOST	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<p>Register of cubs taken prior to start Head counts at various junctions / stops along the route All adults aware of number of cubs Leader at front and leader at rear of walk. Route is familiar to leaders Route length and timings are appropriate to the time available</p>	L	Leader and adult vigilance
CROSSING ROADS	CUBS	<p>Set route to minimise road crossings. Where roads must be crossed the leaders will form corridors across the road and move all cubs at same time.</p>	L	Leader Vigilance
