COVID 19 ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrival and departure staggered to maintain 'bubbles' if multiple groups are meeting and at distance. • One-way system through garden used for arrival/departure if operating near HQ • Cubs et al to sanitise hands on arrival and at regular intervals using their own or group supplied sanitizer OR hot water with soap. COVID 19 SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT WHILST AWAY FROM BASE	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<p>APPOINTED FIRST AIDER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FIRST AID KIT to include foil blanket PLUS PPE of gloves, apron, eye shield & mask • If possible & casualty has minor injury they should 'self-administer first aid', under suitable guidance so suitable Social Distancing can be maintained. • PPE to be donned for anything other than minor • Leader in charge to have all numbers and if necessary wrap casualty in foil blanket and contact ambulance and parents immediately 	M	REINFORCE
VEHICLE MOVEMENTS	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<p>There is a risk of injury from vehicle movements while Cubs move from the Scout Hut to the park at the start and finish of the activity.</p> <p>Cubs to be escorted to and from the group by parents</p> <p>Parents and Leaders to be vigilant all drivers to be careful when manoeuvring</p> <p>Be aware of other park users' movements</p>	L	Maintain vigilance

GAME PLAY	CUBS	<p>All clues must be accessible without the need to touch anything! Eg Laminated and attached to posts by string or staples Wipes/sanitiser must be available If writing is required then each Cub should bring their own named notebook and pen All clues should be removed at the end and rubbish removed Treasure must be individual items with wipeable packaging</p>	L	Leader and adult vigilance
PEOPLE GET LOST	CUBS LEADERS HELPERS	<p>Cubs registered and counted on arrival Cubs move around in groups with leaders Cubs needing the toilet are accompanied by leader Cubs counted at regular intervals Establish a marshalling point for the cubs during the game (near the centre) Walk the cubs around the boundary of the playing area. Set a time for the activity</p>	L	Leader and adult vigilance
INJURY FROM TREES, BRANCHES OR OBSTACLES	ALL	<p>Cubs encouraged not to run and to be cautious when moving between trees The Cubs are all walked around the site prior to the game commencing so they are familiar with the terrain and the constraints of the playing area</p>	L	Leader and adult vigilance
SLIPS AND TRIPS	ALL	<p>The site is generally safe with clearly defined paths, hedges and boundaries. There is a stream running just outside one of the game boundaries.</p>	L	Good Leader Control and Vigilance

REST STOPS	CUBS	Cannot play on the equipment at present Snack time sanitise hands before and after eating Play games on the field which allow social distancing!		
COLD AND WET	CUBS	Ensure the Cubs and YPs are correctly dressed before we leave. Have they the correct footwear, jackets, torches etc Keep an eye on younger Cubs esp	M	Leader Vigilance
