What's The Plan?

Volunteers & Leaders report to the Cub Scout Leader or other Leader in Charge for the duration of the meeting, but we are **all equally there to ensure the safety of ALL of us**, Young People, Parents & Leaders!

We are all working together to ensure:

- We are arriving and departing safely and all properly washing/sanitizing hands on arrival and departure and at regular intervals throughout the meeting.
- Helping and nudging and reminding Cubs and Leaders to socially distance at minimum of 2m or 1m whilst wearing a mask at all times.
- We are not mixing with other groups who may be meeting at the same time (if we were able to run two groups of Cubs leaders and volunteers are not to meet or cross!
- Being alert to members who may look unwell. Flagging this up to the Leader in Charge so they can act accordingly.
- We make sure poor or risky behaviour is nipped in the bud so we can get on and have fun and enjoy our meeting safely!

First Aid

- There are special First Aid bags containing PPE which should be carried at all times you'll be asked to carry one please remind us if we don't have one!
- Where possible first aid should be self-administered by the YP or Adult concerned eg plaster, inhaler
- If this is not possible gloves, apron, mask and eye protection should be worn for all other accidents. Please see the full procedure here under First Aid
